

THE SUNKICKS HOME FOR THE HOLIDAYS

Preliminary Technical Rider (Non-Contractual)

Tour Window: Holiday Season — November through December

Production Overview

The Sunkicks: Home for the Holidays is a touring holiday Broadway-style production featuring precision (Rockettes-Style) choreography, vocals, video integration, and a touring automated lighting system. The production travels with its own LED video wall, lighting package, control systems, costumes, and wardrobe equipment. Audio utilizes the venue's house PA.

Minimum Stage Requirements

- **Clear Stage:** 32' W × 32' D
- **Clear Height:** 18' to lowest obstruction
Larger stages scale beautifully and allow for expanded choreography and flexible video positioning.

Stage Floor

Marley preferred; bare black deck acceptable. Floor must be clean, smooth, and suitable for precision dance. Venue must allow theatrical-grade multi-colored gaff tape and glow tape to be adhered for precision dance positioning and stage alignment.

Rigging & Video

- Touring LED video wall (~2 tons total)
- Requires steel points for (2-4) 1-ton motors
- Video wall is not flown from traditional counterweight line sets or fly rails
- Use of man lift to rigging points provided by venue

Lighting

Touring production travels with a full automated lighting package. Venue specifics may apply. Production may request a venue-provided balcony rail or over-audience front light position to achieve a clean two-color front wash appropriate for precision dance and holiday staging.

Audio

Production utilizes the venue's **house PA system** and travels with:

- Digital console
- Wireless rack and microphones

Power

Requires **two (2) 400A, 208V 3-phase disconnects** for touring lighting and LED video wall systems.

Wardrobe and laundry require standard **110V** service.

Final distribution and cable configuration will be confirmed during technical advance.

Atmospherics / Effects

- Theatrical haze for lighting
 - Water-based faux snow
- Effects are used to enhance staging and seasonal atmosphere.

Company Size

Touring company of **24** performers and **6** crew leads

Dressing Rooms & Wardrobe

- **Minimum dressing rooms:** 2 (16 women) (8 men)
- **Preferred dressing rooms:** 4+

Requires wardrobe and laundry access, including:

- Washers/Dryers
- Steamers/Irons/Ironing Boards
- Costume Racks
- Quick-Change Areas

Crossover

Requires an indoor hallway crossover or enclosed backstage path (non-public).

Runtime

Approx. **90 minutes**.

Can be presented as:

- One Act (no intermission), or
- Two Acts with intermission

Crew

Presenter provides local crew for load-in/out and performance support appropriate to venue. Labor specifics will be confirmed during technical advance.

Local Labor

Local labor requirements vary by venue and may be scaled to facility capabilities. Final labor needs will be determined during technical advance.

Touring Logistics

- **2 × 26' box trucks**

Lodging

- 16 hotel rooms within a 15 minute drive of the venue.
- Hotel should be a minimum of a 3 star rating.

Hospitality

1. Catering / Meals

Load-in / Tech / multi-show days

- **Hot meal** for cast and crew on tech days or between shows on a multi-show day
 - Balanced options: protein, vegetables, starch
 - Vegetarian option required
 - Vegan/gluten-free option strongly preferred
 - Menus discussed in advance with the Company Manager

Short calls or single-show days

- Pre-show light meal (sandwiches, salads, wraps)
- OR - Meal buyout (\$30 per person)

2. Craft Services (Always Requested)

Available **from load-in through strike**:

- Bottled water (or water coolers + refillable bottles)
- Coffee & tea (regular and decaf)
- Dairy free milk option (Oat, almond, ect.)
- Soft drinks and juices

Healthy snacks:

- Fresh Fruit
- Veggie tray
- Granola bars/protein bars
- Nuts, trail mix

Some “comfort snacks” (chips, cookies, etc.)

Hospitality details may vary by venue and will be discussed during buyer advance.
